Boys & Girls Club will provide emergency childcare to support first responders, healthcare workers, essential community personnel, and those parents who must work to maintain employment.

Pasco Licensed Childcare

- Full day programs beginning on Wednesday, March 18th.
- We will operate in Maya, McGee, Twain, Livingston, Three Rivers.
- We will operate program from 6:30am- 6:00pm.
- PSD Janitorial staff will be on site to assist with cleaning and sanitizing.
- PSD will provide breakfast and lunch. BGC will provide afternoon snack.

Richland Licensed Childcare

- Full day programs beginning on Tuesday, March 17th.
- We will operate at Marcus Whitman, White Bluffs, Badger Mountain, Wiley and Sacajawea portables.
- We will operate program from 6:00am- 6:00pm.
- RSD will provide breakfast and lunch. BGC will provide afternoon snack.

Early Learning Programs

- Club Discovery Preschools at Main Branch, Kennewick Club, CBC, & Van Giesen will operate as normal.
- Families served at the Early Learning Center will be moved to Van Giesen.
- Families will not be penalized for choosing to keep their child home.
- We will not charge families that do not attend.

Prosser Club

- Emergency childcare operations will take place beginning Wednesday, March 18th.
- We will operate program from 7:00AM-6:00PM.
- Sliding scale for families based on Free/Reduced lunch status.
- PSD will provide breakfast and lunch. BGC will provide afternoon snack.
- Teen programming will continue through virtual and small group strategies to be identified.

Music and Arts Center

- MAC staff will survey families to determine usage if program continues as normal.
- Families will not be penalized for choosing to keep their child home.
- We will not charge families that do not attend.
- We will increase cleaning and disinfecting procedures, and ensure best practices for hand washing of youth and staff.
- This will be reevaluated each week based on staff availability and community usage.

Pasco Main Branch & Kennewick Club

- MB and KC will be suspending operations beginning March 17th.
- Current families will be offered childcare services offsite with sliding scale.
- Clubs will be evaluated as Emergency Childcare facilities following assessment of community need and discussions with first responders, healthcare workers, and community partners.
- Teen programming will continue through virtual and small group strategies to be identified.
