A *Letter* FROM OUR CEO

As I look back on 2025, I feel extremely grateful for what we have achieved at Clubs and incredibly proud of the work behind it. With more than 200 caring, professional staff members, we are dedicated to creating a world-class experience for all Club youth.

This past year, we had more than 4,200 Club members and served more than 1,000 youth each day. Additionally, we served more than 1,100 teens in 2025, which is the largest number of teens we have ever served in a single year. At the beginning of the year, we opened the doors of our new Prosser Clubhouse, which allowed us to serve 80% more youth in Prosser compared to 2024. Across all 29 Club sites, we continued to provide meaningful and eye-opening opportunities focused on helping our youth develop their health and well-being, character and leadership, academic success, and life and workforce readiness.

Thank you to the many community members and organizations who have helped us make an impact on the lives of local kids and teens. We are honored to be a support system for so many youth and to help ensure a better tomorrow.

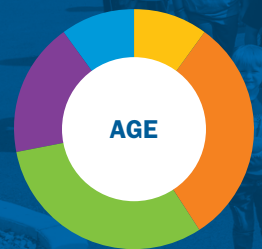

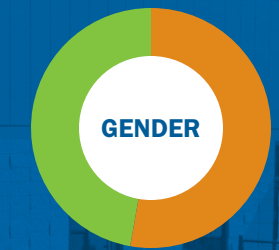

Throughout the year, we served *667 Prosser youth.*

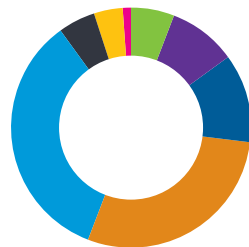
That's an *80%* increase from the 371 youth served in 2024.

This project was made possible thanks to leaders and advocates coming together to understand and act on the needs of our local community.



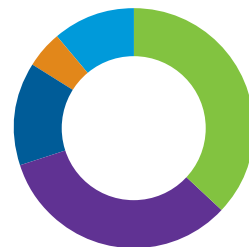
